GAME SUMMARIES:

NEW YORK 73, BUTLER 27

The Griffons receivers are still burning up the league. This week's star performance was from Herman Moore, who led all FFL scorers with a 29 point week. WRs Carl Pickens and Isaac Bruce added 12 and 11, respectively. Seven of 8 starters scored for NY. Butler's rollercoaster found them in a down week, with QB Jeff Blake and WR Eric Metcalf pacing the team with 8 points each.

CAROLINA 47, LOS ANGELES 22

The Big Bang won DESPITE playing QB Trent Dilfer and his 3 points and bypassing QB Scott Mitchell and his potential 14 points. Three Big Bangers tied for the team lead with 11 points each: RBs Erric Pegram and Chris Warren, and K Pete Stoyanovich. The Riot was paced by RB Edgar Bennett, who scored 10.

WISCONSIN 46, STATE COLLEGE 41

Emmitt Smith continued to be the FFL franchise this week, pacing the Cheeseheads with 20 points. QB Eric Zeier, in his Cheesehead debut, chipped in 11 points. Only 2 other Cheeseheads scored - Jay Novacek and Jason Hanson added 6 points apiece. The Bandits were paced by another Andre Rison siting: he scored 20 points. RB Terry Kirby added 10 in the State College effort.

DALLAS 45, PENNSYLVANIA 32

The Armadillos shocked the Wildcats, who have now suffered back-to-back losses for the first time in nearly two years. RB Bernie Parmalee and WR Yancey Thigpen paced Dallas, with 11 points each. Two Wildcat players scored 14 points each: Barry Sanders and Robert Brooks. The rest of the team, however, managed a scant 4 points.

MIAMI 36, RICHMOND 35

Kicker Chris Jacke paced the Muffdivers, with 12 points. WR Rob Moore added 8, as Miami makes a push to stay in the hunt for a playoff spot. The Rattlin' Raptors coaching skills were called into question again as the decision to start Amp Lee instead of Derrick Moore cost the Richmond squad a potential win.

PITTSBURGH 23, MERCER 17

The Pachyderms finally picked up their 2nd win on the season, knocking off the hapless Mustangs as the Mustangs came crashing back to reality after posting their highest score ever the previous week. Kicker Eddie Murray paced Pittsburgh with 12 points. QB Brett Favre added 9. The Mustangs were led by K Norm Johnson's 6-point effort.
