NEW YORK WINS 8th STRAIGHT, OFF TO BEST START EVER!

The Griffons are off to the best start ever in the FFL, now holding an 11-1 record after crushing the PA Wildcats 86-58 in Week 12 action. New York also nailed down the division championship and will enjoy the home field advantage throughout the playoffs.

QUICK GAME SUMMARIES:

NEW YORK 86, PENNSYLVANIA 58

The Griffons had all 8 starters score, and were NOT paced by their wide receivers, for a change. RB Terrell Davis led the team with 23, and QB Jim Kelly added 16. PA was paced by RBs Barry Sanders with 20 and Marshall Faulk with 13.

WISCONSIN 79, PITTSBURGH 36

The Cheeseheads had monster games from three players, who scored all but 3 points for the team: QB Elvis Grbac (27) and RBs Emmitt Smith (26) and Errict Rhett (20). The Pachyderms were paced by QB Brett Favre's 19.

RICHMOND 75, DALLAS 72

Dallas nearly made a miraculous comeback, scoring 53 points in the Monday night game, but were barely held at bay. Richmond had 4 players in double digits: QB Neil O'Donnell (23) and WRs Bill Brooks (17) Fred Barnett (12) and Michael Irvin (11). Dallas was paced by WR Jerry Rice (23) TE Brent Jones (12) and QB Dan Marino (12).

BUTLER 75, CAROLINA 55

The Blowfish remain in the race for the Central Division title with a big win over the Big Bang. QB Jeff Blake led the Blowfish Brigade with 20 points. Three WRs (Metcalf, Perriman and Brown) all scored in double figures. Carolina was paced by WR Terance Mathis, whose 32 points is tops for a WR this year.

STATE COLLEGE 66, LOS ANGELES 50

The Bandits also pull within one game of the division lead with a win over the Riot! SC was paced by QB Warren Moon's 24 points. RB Derek Loville, WR Anthony Miller and K Chris Boniol also scored in double digits. LA was led by WR Cris Carter (20) and RB Ricky Watters (17).

MERCER 60, MIAMI 18

The Mustangs notch their 4th win of the season and severely dampen Miami's playoff hopes. Mercer was led by QB Jeff George's 27-point effort. K Norm Johnson and WR Gary Clark also scored in double digits. Miami's best performance came from K Chris Jacke's 7 points. WR Rob Moore managed to get himself into the record books by becoming the 2nd WR in league history to manage a negative-point performance (he threw an interception).
